Saint Peter

- * Originally named **Simon**, Peter was a fisherman from the region of Galilee.
- * According to the New Testament, he was one of the first disciples called by Jesus Christ.
- * Jesus gave him the name **Peter** (from a Greek word meaning "rock").
- * Peter is traditionally regarded as the leader of the apostles and the first bishop of Rome.
- * In the Gospel accounts, Peter is known for both great faith and human weakness—for example, he famously denied knowing Jesus three times before Jesus' crucifixion, then later became a prominent leader of the early Church.

Saint Paul

- * Paul was originally known as **Saul of Tarsus** and was born in Tarsus.
- * Unlike Peter, Paul was not one of Jesus' original disciples.
- * He initially persecuted Christians but underwent a dramatic conversion experience while traveling to Damascus.
- * After his conversion, he became one of Christianity's most energetic missionaries.
- * Paul travelled throughout parts of the Roman Empire, establishing churches and writing letters (epistles) that now form a significant portion of the New Testament.

Together, they helped transform Christianity from a small movement in Judea into a faith that spread throughout the Mediterranean world.
